IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR VENDORS

If you are new to us, welcome!

About Arriving & Setting Up

- **Vendor spaces are pre-assigned** (except food vendors - see below).
- **The festival goes on rain or shine!**
- **Set up time is 6 AM to 9:15 AM.** Please arrive in time to completely set up your booth by 9:15 am.
- **To do a partial set up on Friday afternoon or evening,** contact us in advance so we can meet you in the park and take you to your assigned spot.
- **When you reach Glen Dyals Park on festival day,** turn right into the festival grounds at the feather flags.
- **Check in near the gazebo,** collect your vendor space number and parking dashboard sign, and follow any directions from there.
- **Food vendors.** You will be directed to pull in along the playground fence line in order of arrival.
- **Generators are not allowed inside the main festival area** (OK for food vendors).
- **Please Note:** Once set up, you are required to stay open during the entire time set for the event, as per your vendor agreement.

A Few Suggestions for Your Best Day

- **We recommend all non-food vendors use tents.** This is a 100% outdoor festival and most booths are in the sun.
- **Bring all the cash and change you will need.** Verizon offers good service from the festival grounds for card transactions.

- **Wearing light long clothing in layers is suggested** for comfort throughout the day.
- **Insect spray or some kind of personal repellent is helpful** as we can have gnats in the morning before it warms up.

- Depending on your starting point, take Hwy 19 or 349 to Old Town (roughly half way between Chiefland and Cross City).
- Turn south on 349 to Suwannee.
